

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 888

1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 6 through 18; pages 2 through 6,  
2 lines 1 through 30; page 7, lines 1 through 7; by striking out  
3 all of said lines on said pages and inserting

4 Section 1. Section 3354(f) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
5 Consolidated Statutes is amended, subsection (d) is amended by  
6 adding a paragraph and the section is amended by adding  
7 subsections to read:

8 § 3354. Additional parking regulations.

10 (d) Person with a disability and disabled veterans.--

11 \* \* \*

12 (2.1) Local authorities may limit access to a parking  
13 space reserved under paragraph (2) to a specific vehicle,  
14 license plate or other method of designation. Under this  
15 paragraph local authorities may charge a reasonable fee and  
16 shall comply with section 6109 (relating to specific powers  
17 of department and local authorities) and the Americans with  
18 Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336, 104 Stat. 327).

20 (d.1) Obstructing movement.--A person may not obstruct a  
21 space on public or private property reserved for a person with a  
22 disability or a part of a curb ramp or the access aisle adjacent  
23 to a parking space reserved for a person with a disability in a  
24 manner that would prevent a person or wheelchair or personal  
25 mobility device from entering or leaving a vehicle legally  
26 parked in an adjoining space.

28 (f) Penalty.--A person violating subsection (a), (b) or (d)  
29 (1) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction,  
30 be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15. A person  
31 violating subsection (d)(2) or (3) or (e) is guilty of a summary  
32 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine  
33 of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200. If a person is  
34 convicted under subsection (d)(2) or (3) in the absence of a  
35 sign stating the penalty amount, the fine imposed may not exceed  
36 \$50. A person violating subsection (d.1) is guilty of a summary  
37 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine

1 of not less than \$100 nor more than \$300.

3 (h) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following  
4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this  
5 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

6 "Access aisle." A physical area marked in accordance with  
7 departmental regulations:

8 (1) designated by white or blue pavement marking hash-  
9 marks, cross-hatching or other similar visual no parking  
10 indicators;

11 (2) which provides additional space for a person using a  
12 wheelchair, wheelchair lift or other mobility device; and

13 (3) which is located adjacent to a parking space  
14 reserved for a person with a disability.

15 "Person with a disability." A person issued a plate or  
16 placard.

17 "Plate or placard." A plate or placard issued under:

18 (1) Section 1338 (relating to person with disability  
19 plate and placard).

20 (2) Section 1342(a) or (b) (relating to veteran plates  
21 and placard).
