1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 2, by striking out "billing
2 implications"

3 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 2 through 10, by striking out
4 "Within 90 days of the effective date of this" in line 2, all of
5 lines 3 through 9 and "facility or home-based and community-
6 based care" in line 10 and inserting

7 A hospital shall provide notice to a patient or patient's
8 designee of the patient's outpatient status, and information
9 that provides a general description of outpatient observation
10 status,

11 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 19 through 30; page 3, lines 1
12 through 3, by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
13 inserting

14 (b) Contents.--A patient notice required under subsection
15 (a) shall include a statement that:

16 (1) outpatient observation status may impact coverage
17 determinations made by the Federal Medicare Program or the
18 patient's insurance company for hospital and posthospital
19 payments;

20 (2) final decisions related to outpatient observation
21 status can be made after a patient is no longer a patient at
22 the hospital and after a patient has received hospital
23 services or other services; and

24 (3) a patient should contact Medicare, Medicaid or any
25 other insurance provider if the patient has specific
26 questions about the coverage.

27 (c) Information.--A hospital shall provide information to a
28 patient concerning observation status as follows:

29 (1) by written notice; and

30 (2) by oral notice, which must include a summary of the
31 notice provided under paragraph (1) or, at the request of the
32 patient, the notice provided under paragraph (1).

1 Section 4. Change in status.

2 If, during or after a patient receives a hospital service, a
3 patient's inpatient stay is later recategorized, a hospital
4 shall not be responsible for a coverage implication or notice
5 requirement under the act.

6 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 15 and 16, by striking out "July 1,
7 2014, or immediately, whichever is later" and inserting
8 in 180 days
