

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1401

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 9, by striking out "AND"

3 ; and designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 263 in Bucks

5 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 9 and 10

6 Section 5. Officer Bradley M. Fox Memorial Highway.

7 (a) Findings.--

8 (1) Police Officer Bradley M. Fox, a native of  
9 Gilbertsville, Pennsylvania, was born on September 14, 1977.

10 (2) Officer Fox graduated from William Tennent High  
11 School in Warminster, Pennsylvania, where he was a talented  
12 hockey player.

13 (3) Officer Fox had a distinguished ten-year career in  
14 the United States Marine Corps, where he completed two tours  
15 of duty in Iraq (2003) and Afghanistan (2005-2006) and earned  
16 the rank of Staff Sergeant.

17 (4) Officer Fox's military citations include the Navy  
18 and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Combat Action Ribbon,  
19 Navy Presidential Unit Citation, Selected Marine Corps  
20 Reserve (X3) Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Iraq  
21 Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal,  
22 Navy Sea Service Deployment Ribbon and the Armed Forces  
23 Reserve Medal.

24 (5) Officer Fox was a seven-year veteran of the Plymouth  
25 Township Police Department and a graduate of the Philadelphia  
26 Police Canine Academy.

27 (6) Officer Fox was killed in the line of duty on  
28 September 13, 2012, when he and his K-9 partner, Jake, were  
29 ambushed by a suspect they had been pursuing on foot.

30 (b) Designation.--The section of Pennsylvania Route 263 in  
31 Bucks County from West Street Road (Route 132) to West Bristol  
32 Road is hereby designated the Officer Bradley M. Fox Memorial  
33 Highway.

34 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
35 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to  
36 traffic in both directions on the highway.
