- to determine the status of each PSAP's 911 system's stage of 25

19	(c) Counties to cooperate Counties shall cooperate with

22	agency to complete a comprehensive inventory of all PSAPs

24	not remit the information requested by the agency within 45 days
25	of the request shall result in the immediate suspension or
26	forfeiture of fund disbursements. The agency, in consultation

29	a report detailing its findings and recommendations to the
