

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 911

Sponsor: REPRESENTATIVE BARBIN

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1 Amend Bill, page 9, by inserting between lines 11 and 12

2 "Next Generation 911" or "NG911." An Internet Protocol (IP)-
3 based system that allows digital information, including voice,
4 photos, videos and text messages, to flow seamlessly from the
5 public, through the 911 network and on to emergency responders.

6 Amend Bill, page 9, by inserting between lines 24 and 25

7 "Pa StarNet." The Commonwealth's Statewide wireless voice
8 and data network for public safety and 911 communications as
9 used by Commonwealth agencies, the General Assembly, certain
10 county and municipal agencies and businesses.

11 Amend Bill, page 12, by inserting between lines 7 and 8

12 "Regional ESiNET." An Internet Protocol-based system which
13 consists of managed networks, shared applications and the
14 ability to replicate emergency 911 features and functions.

15 Amend Bill, page 86, line 9, by striking out "a section" and
16 inserting

18 Amend Bill, page 86, by inserting between lines 16 and 17

19 \$ 5314. Inventory.

20 (a) Comprehensive inventory required.--The agency, in
21 consultation with the Pennsylvania State Police and the board,
22 shall conduct a comprehensive inventory of each county PSAP's
23 facilities, hardware, software, communications infrastructure,
24 network capabilities and related equipment and services procured
25 to determine the status of each PSAP's 911 system's stage of
26 advancement to NG911 and to develop a comprehensive State plan
27 for the implementation, operation, maintenance and funding of a
28 Statewide NG911 emergency services Internet Protocol network
29 that supports the interoperable and coordinated delivery of
30 Federal, State, regional and local government NG911 emergency
31 services.

32 (b) Contents.--The inventory shall include, but is not
33 limited to:

1 (1) A record of databases, networks, radio, telephone
2 and equipment and correlated networks at each PSAP.

3 (2) A record of all data systems, including, but not
4 limited to, call and dispatch and record management systems.

5 (3) PSAP 911 emergency and nonemergency call volumes.

6 (4) Equipment/network system geographic limitations and
7 capabilities.

8 (5) Identification of new equipment that may be required
9 to and equipment that may be reused to achieve NG911 status.

10 (6) A record of equipment or facilities that are or can
11 be shared or colocated.

12 (7) A record of all leased equipment and date of each
13 lease termination date.

14 (8) A record of personnel resources and costs, including
15 pension and benefit obligations at each PSAP.

16 (9) PSAP ease of ability to merge with or form a
17 regional ESiNET or connect directly to PA StarNet or
18 subsequent microwave network.

19 (c) Counties to cooperate.--Counties shall cooperate with
20 the agency by supplying all of the information identified in
21 this section and other information deemed necessary by the
22 agency to complete a comprehensive inventory of all PSAPs
23 operating 911 systems within this Commonwealth. Counties that do
24 not remit the information requested by the agency within 45 days
25 of the request shall result in the immediate suspension or
26 forfeiture of fund disbursements. The agency, in consultation
27 with the board, the Pennsylvania State Police and the Governor's
28 Interoperability Council, shall complete the inventory and issue
29 a report detailing its findings and recommendations to the
30 General Assembly by October 31, 2015. The agency shall be
31 responsible for maintaining and updating the inventory on a
32 biannual basis.
