The condition triggering prescription of the opioid drug product under this 15 paragraph shall be documented in the patient's medical 16 17 record, and the health care practitioner must indicate that a 18 non-opioid drug product alternative was not appropriate to 19 treat the medical condition and that the health care 20 practitioner provided the patient with a pain management 21 referral.
