1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 3, by striking out "AND,"

2 Amend Bill, page 1, line 6, by inserting after "mechanics"

3 ; and, in size, weight and load, further providing for permit
4 for movement during course of manufacture

5 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 4 and 5

6 Section 2. Section 4968(a.1)(3) of Title 75 is amended,
7 subsection (a.2) is amended by adding a paragraph and subsection
8 (b) is amended by adding a definition to read:

9 § 4968. Permit for movement during course of manufacture.

10 (a.1) General rule.--An annual permit may be issued
11 authorizing movement on specified highways of:

12 * * *

13 (3) aircraft refueling vehicles or vehicles and
14 combinations carrying milk, raw coal, flat-rolled steel
15 coils, steel slabs, hot ingots, a hot box, pulpwood and wood
16 chips, raw water or cryogenic liquid or sugar which exceed
17 the maximum weight specified in Subchapter C while they are
18 in the course of manufacture and under contract with or under
19 the direct control of the manufacturer, provided that they do
20 not exceed the maximum height, width or length specified in
21 Subchapter B unless they also qualify under paragraph (1),
22 subject to the provisions in subsection (a.2).

23 (a.2) Specifications.--

24 * * *

25 (14) A combination vehicle hauling sugar may be
26 permitted by the department and local authorities to move
27 upon specified highways within their respective jurisdictions
28 a distance not exceeding five miles if the gross weight does
29 not exceed 95,000 pounds and the weight of any nonsteering
30 axle does not exceed 21,000 pounds. No permit may be issued
31 for this type of movement upon an interstate highway.

32 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
33 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
34 subsection:

36 "Sugar." The term shall refer to granulated raw, semi-

1 refined or refined sugar derived from the processing of sugar
2 cane or sugar beets, requiring further processing and not
3 intended for direct consumption or retail sale.
