- (a) Patient information. -- The department shall maintain a confidential list of patients and caregivers to whom it has 9 issued identification cards. Individual identifying information 10 about patients and caregivers obtained by the department, including certifications issued by practitioners, the information on identification cards and information provided by the Pennsylvania State Police pursuant to section 506(b) shall be confidential and exempt from public disclosure, including disclosure under the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law.
 - Medical marijuana organizations and practitioners. -- The following are public records under the Right-to-Know Law:
 - (1) An application for registration as a medical marijuana organization. The department shall maintain a separate list of names, addresses and telephone numbers of medical marijuana organizations.
 - (2) The names, business addresses and medical credentials of practitioners. All other practitioner registration information shall be confidential and exempt from public disclosure under the Right-to-Know Law.
