- 14 WHEREAS, Those American citizens and permanent residents 15 named to the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Terrorist 16 Watchlist are unrestricted from purchasing and owning firearms 17 despite the hazard they potentially pose to American life and 18 liberty; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Between 2004 and 2014, more than 2,043 people have 20 lawfully purchased a firearm despite being listed on the Federal 21 Bureau of Investigation's Terrorist Watchlist; therefore be it

- 24 urge the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the

- 27 to ban the purchase and ownership of firearms by potential
- 28 terrorists named to the Terrorist Watchlist; and be it further
