6 Section 703. Underground Storage Tank Indemnification Board.

7 (a) Establishment of board, appointment and terms.--There is
8 hereby created the Underground Storage Tank Indemnification
9 Board which shall consist of [ten] 14 members. The Insurance
10 Commissioner and the Secretary of [the Department of]
11 Environmental Protection shall be ex officio members. Two
12 members shall be appointed from the Senate, one member by the
13 President pro tempore of the Senate and one member by the
14 Minority Leader of the Senate. Two members shall be appointed
15 from the House of Representatives, one member by the Speaker of
16 the House of Representatives and one member by the Minority
17 Leader of the House of Representatives. Eight members shall be
18 appointed by the Governor, as follows:

19 (1) Six members who shall be persons with particular
20 expertise in the management of underground storage tanks.
21 Three of these members shall be appointed for terms of four
22 years and three shall be appointed for a term of three years.
23 The Governor shall appoint the members, one each from a list
24 of nominees provided by each of the following:

25 (i) The Associated Petroleum Industries of
26 Pennsylvania.

27 (ii) The Pennsylvania Petroleum Association.

28 (iii) The Service Station Dealers and Automotive
29 Repair Association of Pennsylvania and Delaware and the
30 Petroleum Retailers and Auto Repair Association, Inc.

31 (iv) [The Middle Atlantic Truck Stop Operators.] A
32 Statewide organization representing fuel retailers and
33 food merchants.

34 (v) The Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, Pennsylvania State
35 Grange and Pennsylvania Farmers Union.

36 (vi) The Tank Installers of Pennsylvania.

1 (2) One local government member who shall have knowledge
2 and expertise in underground storage tanks. The local
3 government member shall be appointed for a term of two years.

4 (3) One public member who shall not be an owner or
5 operator of storage tanks nor affiliated in any way with any
6 person regulated under this act. The public member shall be
7 appointed for a term of three years.

8 * * *

9 (f) Meetings; quorum.--The board shall meet at least
10 quarterly. Additional meetings may be held upon reasonable
11 notice at times and locations selected by the board. The board
12 shall meet at the call of the chairman or upon written request
13 of three members of the board. [Six] Eight members shall
14 constitute a quorum and a quorum may act for the board in all
15 matters.
