1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 1, by striking out all of said line
2 and inserting

3 (a.2) Relief.--[A]

4 (1) Except as set forth in paragraph (2), a person
5 adversely affected by an ordinance,

6 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 7 and 8

7 (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to a challenge of a
8 requirement that, if reasonable efforts of law enforcement
9 fail to identify the lawful owner of a confiscated or
10 recovered firearm within 120 days after law enforcement comes
11 into possession of the firearm or if the lawful owner of the
12 firearm is identified but otherwise prohibited from
13 possessing the firearm:

14 (i) law enforcement shall destroy the firearm
15 immediately; or

16 (ii) if the firearm is evidence in an ongoing
17 investigation or in a criminal prosecution or civil
18 litigation, law enforcement shall destroy the firearm
19 when:

20 (A) the investigation is complete; or

21 (B) a court of competent jurisdiction issues an
22 order authorizing the destruction of the firearm.
