8 "Emergency service responder." An individual acting in an
9 official capacity as any of the following:

- 10 (1) A police officer.
- 11 (2) A sheriff or deputy sheriff.
- 12 (3) A coroner or deputy coroner.
- 13 (4) A firefighter.
- 14 (5) Fire police.
- 15 (6) A fire marshal.
- 16 (7) A medical examiner or deputy medical examiner.
- 17 (8) Rescue personnel.
- 18 (9) Ambulance personnel.
- 19 (10) Towing and recovery personnel.
- 20 (11) Highway maintenance and construction personnel.
- 21 (12) Hazardous material response team member.
- 22 (13) Emergency medical services personnel.
- 23 (14) Contractors or employees of a public utility as
24 defined under 66 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to definitions), a
25 municipally owned utility or an electric cooperative as
26 defined in 15 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 (relating to electric
27 cooperative corporations).
- 28 (15) A police officer who is also a member of a county
29 or regional municipal special emergency response team which
30 is authorized to respond to emergencies under 42 Pa.C.S. §
31 8953 (relating to Statewide municipal police jurisdiction).

9 (b.2) Police officer special emergency response team
10 members.--A privately owned vehicle used in responding to an
11 emergency under 42 Pa.C.S. § 8953 (relating to Statewide
12 municipal police jurisdiction) by a police officer who is also a
13 member of a county or regional special emergency response team
14 shall be equipped with revolving or flashing red lights and an
15 audible warning system in accordance with subsection (a) subject
16 to the lights and audible warning system being returned to the
17 head of the special emergency response team upon termination of
18 a person's active status as a police officer or active member of
19 a special emergency response team.

21 (f) Conformity with department regulations.--Except as
22 provided under [subsection] subsections (b.1)(1.1) and (b.2),
23 all equipment authorized or required by this section shall
