1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 2, by striking out "AND"

2 Amend Bill, page 2, line 5, by striking out the period after

6 with State Route 1010 and State Route 1027, commonly referred
7 to as the Market Street Bridge, as the Senator Harold Mowery
8 Market Street Bridge.

10 Section 11. Senator Harold Mowery Market Street Bridge.

11 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
12 follows:

13 (1) Harold F. Mowery, Jr., was born January 4, 1930, in
14 Chambersburg and was raised in Mechanicsburg.

15 (2) As a graduate of Mechanicsburg High School and
16 Dickinson College, Mr. Mowery was a product of the
17 Pennsylvania education system.

18 (3) Mr. Mowery entered the insurance business in 1954
19 and earned a chartered life underwriter degree. Over several
20 decades, Mr. Mowery founded several highly successful
21 insurance businesses which employed hundreds of
22 Pennsylvanians.

23 (4) Mr. Mowery was elected to the House of
24 Representatives of Pennsylvania in 1976 and went on to serve
25 seven terms. In the House of Representatives, Mr. Mowery
26 achieved a reputation for expertise on fiscal and pension
27 issues and advocated for the adoption of private-sector
28 business principles to the operation of public programs and
29 State spending. He was also instrumental in establishing the
30 Public Employee Retirement Commission.

31 (5) In 1990, Mr. Mowery became part of State political
32 history as the Republican candidate for Lieutenant Governor
33 on the ticket headed by Barbara Hafer.

34 (6) In 1992, Mr. Mowery was elected to represent the
35 31st District in the Senate of Pennsylvania. He served with

1 distinction until his retirement in 2004.

2 (7) During his time in the Senate, Senator Mowery
3 enriched the lives of thousands as Chairperson of the Public
4 Health and Welfare Committee and Vice Chairperson of the
5 Education Committee. He also served as Vice Chairperson of
6 the Legislative Data Processing Committee and as a rank-and-
7 file member of numerous standing committees, including
8 Banking and Insurance, Law and Justice and Labor and
9 Industry.

10 (8) During and after his public service career, Senator
11 Mowery was a prominent community leader. He supported the
12 establishment of the Camp Hill Lion Foundation to enhance
13 academic, athletic and cultural resources. He was also a
14 supporter of the Whitaker Center for Science and the Arts,
15 the construction of the Grace Milliman Pollock Performing
16 Arts Center and the performing arts, including the Harrisburg
17 Symphony Orchestra. Senator Mowery aided many charities by
18 sponsoring and supporting benefits, galas and community
19 fundraisers.

20 (9) Senator Mowery's professional achievements,
21 extensive community involvement and the myriad of awards and
22 accolades he received stand as strong testimony to his
23 genuine concern for the well-being of the Commonwealth and
24 the people of the 31st Senatorial District.

25 (10) By all accounts, Senator Mowery was a loving family
26 man, a respected businessperson and a dedicated and
27 accomplished public servant worthy of emulation for
28 generations to come.

29 (b) Designation.--The bridge carrying State Route 3012 over
30 the Susquehanna River between City Island and the intersection
31 with State Route 1010 and State Route 1027, commonly referred to
32 as the Market Street Bridge, is hereby designated as the Senator
33 Harold Mowery Market Street Bridge.

34 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
35 maintain architecturally appropriate signs displaying the name
36 of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.
