Firearms not to be carried without a license. * * * 15 16 (b) Exceptions.--The provisions of subsection (a) shall not 17 apply to: 18 (1) Constables, sheriffs, prison or jail wardens, or 19 their deputies, policemen of this Commonwealth or its 20 political subdivisions, or other law-enforcement officers. 21 (2) Members of the army, navy, marine corps, air force or coast guard of the United States or of the National Guard 22 23 or organized reserves when on duty. 24 (3) The regularly enrolled members of any organization 25 duly organized to purchase or receive such firearms from the 26 United States or from this Commonwealth. 27 [(4) Any persons engaged in target shooting with a firearm, if such persons are at or are going to or from their 28 29 places of assembly or target practice and if, while going to 30 or from their places of assembly or target practice, the 31 firearm is not loaded.]

(5) Officers or employees of the United States duly authorized to carry a concealed firearm.

(6) Agents, messengers and other employees of common carriers, banks, or business firms, whose duties require them to protect moneys, valuables and other property in the discharge of such duties.

7 (7) Any person engaged in the business of manufacturing,
8 repairing, or dealing in firearms, or the agent or
9 representative of any such person, having in his possession,
10 using or carrying a firearm in the usual or ordinary course
11 of such business.

12 (8) Any person while [carrying a firearm] transporting a 13 firearm as provided under 23 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to 14 protection from abuse) which is not loaded and is in a secure 15 wrapper. [from the place of purchase to his home or place of 16 business, or to a place of repair, sale or appraisal or back 17 to his home or place of business, or in moving from one place 18 of abode or business to another or from his home to a 19 vacation or recreational home or dwelling or back, or to 20 recover stolen property under section 6111.1(b)(4) (relating 21 to Pennsylvania State Police), or to a place of instruction 22 intended to teach the safe handling, use or maintenance of 23 firearms or back or to a location to which the person has 24 been directed to relinquish firearms under 23 Pa.C.S. § 6108 25 (relating to relief) or back upon return of the relinguished 26 firearm or to a licensed dealer's place of business for 27 relinguishment pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S. § 6108.2 (relating to 28 relinguishment for consignment sale, lawful transfer or 29 safekeeping) or back upon return of the relinguished firearm 30 or to a location for safekeeping pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S. § 31 6108.3 (relating to relinguishment to third party for 32 safekeeping) or back upon return of the relinquished 33 firearm.]

(9) Persons licensed to hunt, take furbearers or fish in
this Commonwealth, if such persons are actually hunting,
taking furbearers or fishing as permitted by such license, or
are going to the places where they desire to hunt, take
furbearers or fish or returning from such places.

(10) Persons training dogs, if such persons are actuallytraining dogs during the regular training season.

(11) Any person while carrying a firearm in any vehicle,
which person possesses a valid and lawfully issued license
for that firearm which has been issued under the laws of the
United States or any other state.

45 (12) A person who has a lawfully issued license to carry 46 a firearm pursuant to section 6109 (relating to licenses) and 47 that said license expired within six months prior to the date 48 of arrest and that the individual is otherwise eligible for 49 renewal of the license.

50 (13) Any person who is otherwise eligible to possess a 51 firearm under this chapter and who is operating a motor

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1 vehicle which is registered in the person's name or the name 2 of a spouse or parent and which contains a firearm for which 3 a valid license has been issued pursuant to section 6109 to 4 the spouse or parent owning the firearm. [(14) A person lawfully engaged in the interstate 5 transportation of a firearm as defined under 18 U.S.C. § 6 7 921(a)(3) (relating to definitions) in compliance with 18 8 U.S.C. § 926A (relating to interstate transportation of 9 firearms).] 10 (15) Any person who possesses a valid and lawfully 11 issued license or permit to carry a firearm which has been 12 issued under the laws of another state, regardless of whether 13 a reciprocity agreement exists between the Commonwealth and 14 the <u>other</u> state under section 6109(k), provided[: 15 (i) The] the other state provides a reciprocal 16 privilege for individuals licensed to carry firearms under section 6109. 17 18 [(ii) The Attorney General has determined that the 19 firearm laws of the state are similar to the firearm laws 20 of this Commonwealth.] 21 (16) Any person holding a license in accordance with 22 section 6109(f)(3). 23 (17) Any person who is not otherwise prohibited from possessing, using, controlling, selling, transferring or 24 25 manufacturing a firearm shall be entitled to transport a firearm if all of the following apply: 26 (i) During the transportation, the firearm is not 27 28 loaded. 29 (ii) The firearm is not being transported for 30 purposes prohibited under the laws of this Commonwealth. * * * 31 32 Section 2.2.
