

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 383

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 13, by striking out all of said line  
2 and inserting

3 Section 510.3. Protection and Defense of Pupils.--(a) (1)

5 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 16 and 17

6 (2) A board of school directors that establishes a policy  
7 under this section shall do all of the following:

8 (i) Establish a firearm safety plan. The board of school  
9 directors shall file the firearm safety plan with the law  
10 enforcement agency that provides law enforcement services to the  
11 school. A firearm safety plan shall not be deemed to be a public  
12 record under the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known  
13 as the "Right-to-Know Law." The firearm safety plan shall  
14 include all of the following:

15 (A) Identification of the school personnel permitted access  
16 to firearms pursuant to this section.

17 (B) Coordination between the law enforcement agency and  
18 school personnel, including the school personnel permitted  
19 access to firearms under this section, during an emergency  
20 response.

21 (C) Procedures for the law enforcement agency to review the  
22 discharge of firearms in the buildings or on the grounds of the  
23 school that are owned by school personnel permitted access to  
24 firearms under this section.

25 (ii) Provide notification of the establishment of the policy  
26 to the parents and guardians of all students enrolled in each  
27 school of the school district that has school personnel who are  
28 permitted access to firearms under this section.

29 (iii) Provide notification to the nearest hospital of the  
30 number of schools in the school district where school personnel  
31 have access to firearms in the buildings and on the property of  
32 the schools.

3        (3) Complete a psychological evaluation administered under  
4 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to municipal police  
5 education and training) and receive a professional opinion from  
6 the evaluating psychologist that the individual is  
7 psychologically capable of exercising appropriate judgment and  
8 restraint as an individual authorized to have access to firearms  
9 in the buildings or on the grounds of a school.

11 FEBRUARY 14, 2008 (P.L.6, NO.3), KNOWN AS THE"
