"Child care facility." Any of the following:

- A premises in which care is provided for a period exceeding twenty-four hours for a child under 16 years of age who is not a relative of the operator and who is not accompanied by a parent, individual standing in loco parentis or legal quardian. For purposes of this paragraph, the term does not include a premises selected for care of a child by a parent, individual standing in loco parentis or legal quardian for a period of 30 days or less or a facility operated under social service auspices.
- (2) A premises in which child care is provided simultaneously for seven or more children who are not relatives of the operator, except a facility operated under social service auspices.
- (3) A home where child care is provided at any time to no less than four children and no more than six children who are not relatives of the caregiver.
