15 § 4901. Definitions.

16 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter  
17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the  
18 context clearly indicates otherwise:

19 "Advisor." The Homeland Security Advisor under section  
20 4902(c) (relating to office).

21 "Director." The Homeland Security Director under section  
22 4902(d).

23 "Office." The Governor's Office of Homeland Security  
24 established under section 4902(a).

25 § 4902. Office.

26 (a) Establishment.--The Governor's Office of Homeland  
27 Security is established within the Office of the Governor to  
28 prepare for, prevent, respond to and recover from acts of  
29 terrorism.

30 (b) Powers and duties.--The office has the power and duty  
31 to:

32 (1) Secure this Commonwealth from acts of terrorism.

33 (2) Reduce the vulnerability of critical infrastructure  
34 and key resources to terrorist attacks.

35 (3) Partner with the United States Department of  
36 Homeland Security and other Federal, State and local agencies  
37 in matters related to homeland security.

1       (4) Work with the Primary State Fusion Center to develop  
2 the process of information fusion for the gathering,  
3 processing, analyzing and disseminating of information  
4 related to homeland security.

5       (5) Cooperate with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management  
6 Agency in matters relating to emergency management planning,  
7 preparedness and response.

8       (6) Participate, in concert with the private sector and  
9 other Federal, State and local agencies, in a coordinated  
10 effort to prepare for, prevent, respond to and recover from  
11 acts of terrorism.

12       (c) Homeland Security Advisor.---The head of the office  
13 shall be the Homeland Security Advisor, as appointed by the  
14 Governor. The advisor shall serve as this Commonwealth's primary  
15 point of contact with the United States Department of Homeland  
16 Security and other Federal, State and local agencies in matters  
17 related to homeland security. The advisor shall advise and  
18 report to the Governor.

19       (d) Homeland Security Director.--The office shall be managed  
20 by a Homeland Security Director appointed by the Governor. The  
21 director shall report to the advisor and to the Governor's  
22 Deputy Chief of Staff for Public Safety. The director shall be  
23 assisted by personnel deemed necessary to allow the office to  
24 carry out its responsibilities.

25       (e) Staffing and location.--The director is authorized to  
26 select, appoint and employ such employees as may be necessary to  
27 carry out the functions of the office, in accordance with the  
28 procedures of the Governor's Office of Administration. The  
29 office shall be located at Pennsylvania State Police  
30 Departmental Headquarters. All personnel assigned to the office  
31 shall be classified as authorized employees of the Pennsylvania  
32 State Police.

33       § 4903. Designation of State administrative agency.

34       The Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency is designated as  
35 the State Administrative Agency for this Commonwealth and shall  
36 be responsible for the administration and audit functions of all  
37 Federal grants relating to homeland security. The distribution  
38 awards of Federal grant money under the Homeland Security Grant  
39 Program and the Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant Program  
40 shall be made by the Governor's Office, in consultation with the  
41 advisor and the Director of the Pennsylvania Emergency  
42 Management Agency, in accordance with the Federal guidelines  
43 related to the National Homeland Security Strategy and Federal  
44 Grant Guidance as promulgated by the United States Department of  
45 Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency  
46 for the respective grant years.

47       § 4904. Cooperation by State agencies.

48       All agencies under the Governor's jurisdiction shall  
49 cooperate with and provide assistance and support as needed by  
50 the office and the Governor's Deputy Chief of Staff for Public  
51 Safety to carry out the functions of the office effectively.
