1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 7, by inserting after "examinations"  
2 ; and, in reimbursements by Commonwealth and between school  
3 districts, further providing for State reimbursement for  
4 health services

5 Amend Bill, page 5, by inserting between lines 4 and 5

6 Section 3. Section 2505.1(b.1) of the act is amended to  
7 read:

8 Section 2505.1. State Reimbursement for Health Services.--\*  
9 \* \*

10 (b.1) Every school district which renders health services to  
11 children shall be reimbursed by the Commonwealth on account of  
12 health services which conform to standards approved by the  
13 Secretary of Health. Reimbursement shall be paid by the  
14 Secretary of Health[.] as follows:

15 (1) For the school year 1990-1991, the amount of this  
16 reimbursement for this subsection shall be the sum of five  
17 dollars and ninety cents (\$5.90) multiplied by the average daily  
18 membership of each school district.

19 (2) For the school year 1991-1992 [and each school year  
20 thereafter] through the school year 2019-2020, the amount of  
21 this reimbursement for this subsection shall be the sum of nine  
22 dollars and seventy cents (\$9.70) multiplied by the average  
23 daily membership of each school district.

24 (3) For the school year 2020-2021 and each school year  
25 thereafter, the amount of this reimbursement shall be determined  
26 for a school year as follows:

27 (i) Multiply:

28 (A) Nine dollars and seventy cents (\$9.70) by;

29 (B) the average daily membership of each school district.

30 (ii) Divide:

31 (A) the school district's number of students who are  
32 economically disadvantaged; by

33 (B) the total enrollment of each school district.

34 (iii) Multiply:

35 (A) the quotient under subparagraph (ii); by

36 (B) the average daily membership of each school district.

37 (iv) Multiply:

1     (A) the product under subparagraph (iii); by

2     (B) forty dollars (\$40).

3     (v) Add:

4     (A) the product under subparagraph (i); and

5     (B) the product under subparagraph (iv).

6     (vi) As used in this paragraph, the term "economically  
7 disadvantaged" shall mean the economically disadvantaged status  
8 of a student as reported by a school district, intermediate unit  
9 or area career and technical school, through the Pennsylvania  
10 Information Management System and determined based upon poverty  
11 data sources such as eligibility for Temporary Assistance for  
12 Needy Families, Medicaid or free or reduced-price lunch; census  
13 data; residence in an institution for the neglected or  
14 delinquent; and residence in a foster home.
