2 Section 8. Construction.

3 Nothing in this act shall be construed to prohibit a State  
4 administrative agency from ending any waiver or suspension of  
5 regulations deemed to be no longer necessary during the period  
6 of the COVID-19 disaster declaration.

7 Section 9. Applicability.

8 The provisions of this act shall not apply to administrative  
9 flexibilities no longer in effect on the date the COVID-19  
10 disaster declaration expires or is terminated by executive  
11 order, proclamation or operation of law. If a State  
12 administrative agency has submitted a public notice to the  
13 Legislation Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania  
14 Bulletin that provides for the expiration or termination date of  
15 an administrative flexibility before the expiration or  
16 termination of the COVID-19 disaster declaration, the  
17 administrative flexibility shall be deemed expired or terminated  
18 for purposes of this act before the end of the COVID-19 disaster  
19 declaration.
