6 Section 1. Section 15 of the act of April 23, 1956 (1955
7 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the Disease Prevention and Control
8 Act of 1955, is amended to read:

11 (2) For the duration of the proclamation of disaster
12 emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published
13 at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the
14 state of disaster emergency thereafter, in each county of
15 this Commonwealth the department or local health department
16 shall release, within 24 hours of receiving information of a
17 confirmed case of COVID-19, the address of a confirmed case
18 of COVID-19 to public safety answering points, as defined
19 under 35 Pa.C.S. § 5302 (relating to definitions). A public
20 safety answering point shall provide law enforcement
21 officers, fire department personnel and emergency medical
22 services personnel the address of a confirmed case of COVID-
23 19. Recipients of this data shall only use the data for the
24 purpose of notifying officers and personnel that there has
25 been a case of COVID-19 at the address to which law
26 enforcement officers, fire department personnel and emergency
27 medical services personnel have been called to perform an
28 essential job function. Officers and personnel receiving this
29 data may not use or disclose the data for any purpose other
30 than to carry out their essential job function at a given
31 address.

32 (3) Paragraph (2) shall expire upon the termination or
33 expiration under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general

1 authority of Governor) of the disaster emergency described in
2 paragraph (2) or the renewal of the disaster emergency
3 described in paragraph (2), whichever is later.
