The information under this subparagraph shall 13 include a statement that the purchaser should contact the 14 15 building code official or the Department of Labor and Industry, whichever is applicable for the municipality_ 16 17 where the property is located, to obtain additional 18 information about the requirements of the Uniform Construction Code. 19 20 (iii) Plain language information explaining that municipalities may have enacted municipal zoning 21 ordinances or other municipal ordinances, which may 22 23 require a permit, a variance or other compliance measures 24 before construction on a property may commence. The information under this subparagraph shall include a 25 statement that the purchaser should contact the 26 municipality where the property is located to obtain 27 28 additional information about how to comply with municipal 29 requirements.
