A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of January 27 through February 2, 2019, as
2 "Catholic Schools Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Catholic schools in this Commonwealth are
4 celebrating "Catholic Schools Week" from January 27 through
5 February 2, 2019; and

6 WHEREAS, The theme for "Catholic Schools Week" this year is
7 "Catholic Schools: Learn. Serve. Lead. Succeed"; and

8 WHEREAS, Catholic schools seek to provide high academic
9 standards, positive spiritual values and a safe school
10 environment for their students to learn and grow into successful
11 adults; and

12 WHEREAS, Catholic schools instill in young people a solid
13 foundation of strong values, teaching commitment to serving the
14 needs of others in society, helping them to build healthy self-
15 esteem and develop leadership skills; and

1 WHEREAS, Administrators and teachers of Catholic schools seek
2 to form a partnership with each student's family, encouraging
3 the input and involvement of parents in the education of their
4 children, which leads to higher attendance rates and lower
5 dropout rates; and

6 WHEREAS, Catholic schools are highly focused upon students
7 dutifully completing their studies and homework, which helps
8 students to develop effective writing skills and prepares them
9 for standardized testing and higher education; and

10 WHEREAS, Catholic schools place special emphasis upon the
11 religious, moral and spiritual development of each student and
12 help them to understand that each person is valuable and unique
13 and has a special place in this world; and

14 WHEREAS, Catholic schools provide young people with the solid
15 values and academic skills needed to become responsible and
16 productive residents of this Commonwealth; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
18 week of January 27 through February 2, 2019, as "Catholic
19 Schools Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

21 congratulations and appreciation to Catholic elementary and
22 secondary schools across this Commonwealth on the occasion of
23 "Catholic Schools Week."
