12	Section 411. AuditorsAt each municipal election, the
13	electors of each township shall elect one auditor to serve for a
14	term of six years from the first Monday of January next
15	following his election.
16	No auditor shall at the same time hold any other elective or
17	appointive township office in the township in which he is
18	employed as an auditor if he audits any finances or any funds
19	belonging to or controlled by the township, and no auditor shall

at the same time hold any other elective or appointive school
district office or employment in any school district of the
second, third or fourth class if he audits any finances or any
funds belonging to or controlled by the school district.
Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
