Definitions. 12 13 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 14 context clearly indicates otherwise: 15 16 *

1	"Eligible adult." A person who meets the following criteria:
2	(1) Is at least 17 years of age.
3	(2) Is a resident of this Commonwealth.
4	(3) [Does not hold a high school diploma or its
5	equivalent.
б	(4)] Is not currently enrolled in a public or private
