## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for
- 3 Medical Advisory Board.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1517 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1517. Medical Advisory Board.
- 9 (a) Membership.--There shall be a Medical Advisory Board
- 10 consisting of [13] <u>14</u> members appointed by the secretary. The
- 11 board shall be composed of an authorized representative from the
- 12 Department of Transportation, [Department of Justice] OFFICE OF <--
- 13 GENERAL COUNSEL, Governor's Council on Drug and Alcohol Abuse,
- 14 Department of Health, Pennsylvania State Police and
- 15 professionals as follows: One neurologist, one doctor of
- 16 cardiovascular disease, one doctor of internal medicine, one
- 17 general practitioner, one ophthalmologist, one psychiatrist, one

- 1 orthopedic surgeon [and]\_ one optometrist and one certified
- 2 <u>driving rehabilitation specialist</u>.
- 3 (b) Duties. -- The board may advise the department and review
- 4 regulations proposed by the department concerning physical and
- 5 mental criteria including vision standards relating to the
- 6 licensing of drivers under the provisions of this chapter.
- 7 <u>(c) Definition.—As used in this section, the term</u>

- 8 <u>"certified driving rehabilitation specialist" means an</u>
- 9 <u>individual who plans, develops, coordinates and implements</u>
- 10 <u>driver rehabilitation services for individuals with disabilities</u>
- 11 <u>and is certified by a national organization that assesses</u>
- 12 <u>knowledge and skills in the services.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
