- 5 WHEREAS, Sentence pursuant to a finding of guilty was imposed
- 6 by the court on July 30, 1975; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to Article II, section
- 9 11, of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,
- 10 does hereby expel Leonard E. Sweeney as a member of the House of
- 11 Representatives and declares that a vacancy in the 17th
- 12 legislative district now exists; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 14 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania petitions and directs the Speaker

- 1 of the House of Representatives to issue a writ for a special
- 2 election to fill said vacancy, pursuant to section 628 of the
- 3 act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the
- 4 "Pennsylvania Election Code."
