## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for property owner's bill of rights statement.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Property
- 6 Owner's Bill of Rights Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Acquiring agency." The term shall have the same meaning as
- 12 provided under 26 Pa.C.S. § 103 (relating to definitions).
- "Condemn." The term shall have the same meaning as provided
- 14 under 26 Pa.C.S. § 103.
- 15 Section 3. Property owner's bill of rights statement.
- 16 (a) General rule. -- The Attorney General shall prepare a
- 17 written statement that includes a bill of rights for an owner
- 18 whose property may be condemned by an acquiring agency through

- 1 the use of the agency's eminent domain authority under 26
- 2 Pa.C.S. (relating to eminent domain).
- 3 (b) Bill of rights.--The property owner's bill of rights
- 4 must notify the property owner of the right to:
- 5 (1) notice of the proposed acquisition of the owner's
- 6 property;
- 7 (2) just compensation and other damages for the property
- 8 condemned;
- 9 (3) a hearing under 26 Pa.C.S. Ch. 5 (relating to
- 10 procedure for determining damages) to determine just
- 11 compensation and measure of damages; and
- 12 (4) an appeal of a judgment in a condemnation
- proceeding, including an appeal of an assessment of damages.
- 14 Section 4. Written statement.
- 15 (a) Requirement. -- The written statement under section 3(a)
- 16 shall include all of the following:
- 17 (1) The title "Property Owner's Bill of Rights."
- 18 (2) A description of each of the following:
- 19 (i) The procedure to condemn under 26 Pa.C.S. Ch. 3
- 20 (relating to procedure to condemn).
- 21 (ii) The procedure for determining damages under 26
- Pa.C.S. Ch. 5 (relating to procedure for determining
- damages).
- 24 (iii) The acquiring agency's obligations to the
- 25 property owner.
- 26 (iv) The property owner's rights during a
- condemnation, including the right of appeal.
- 28 (b) Construction. -- The written statement shall:
- 29 (1) Be in plain language easily understood by the
- 30 average property owner.

- 1 (2) Be provided by the acquiring agency with the written
- 2 notice required under 26 Pa.C.S. § 305(a) (relating to notice
- 3 to condemnee).
- 4 (3) Be available on the Office of Attorney General's
- 5 publicly accessible Internet website.
- 6 Section 5. Notice.
- 7 The property owner's bill of rights shall be provided to the
- 8 last known address of the property owner at least seven days
- 9 before the agency's declaration of taking under 26 Pa.C.S. § 302
- 10 (relating to declaration of taking).
- 11 Section 6. Disclaimer.
- 12 The written statement provided under section 3 shall include
- 13 a disclaimer that the information provided in the property
- 14 owner's bill of rights pertains only to real property subject to
- 15 an acquiring agency's authority under 26 Pa.C.S. (relating to
- 16 eminent domain) and is not legal advice or intended to be a
- 17 substitute for legal counsel.
- 18 Section 7. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
