A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing Congress to review the current foreclosure 2 practice of the Farmers Home Administration. 3 WHEREAS, The Farmers Home Administration was created to assist low-income rural residents towards purchasing homes; and 5 WHEREAS, The FHA FMHA has in Pennsylvania and in other states 6 implemented foreclosure practices that appear to be more 7 restrictive than local lending institutions; and 8 WHEREAS, This policy has resulted in mortgage foreclosures of homeowners who are disabled, unemployed or underemployed through 10 no fault of their own and in many instances these homeowners are 11 continuing to make payments towards principal and/or interest; 12 and 13 WHEREAS, This practice appears to be in contradiction to the 14 original intent of the FHA FMHA; therefore be it 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the United States Congress to review the current foreclosure 16 17 practice of the Farmers Home Mortgage Administration; and be it
