## AN ACT

- Designating a portion of Johnson Mill Road (State Route 1001) from the bridge over Buffalo Creek (Bridge Key 33467) to the 2 intersection of Colonel John Kelly Road (State Route 1002) in 3
- Buffalo Township, Union County, as the Sgt. Edward L. Shannon 4
- Memorial Highway. 5
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Sqt. Edward L. Shannon Memorial Highway. 8
- 9 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 10 follows:
- Edward L. Shannon was born March 6, 1895, in 11
- 12 Mazeppa, Union County.
- 13 He served in World War I with the 103rd Trench
- 14 Mortar Battery in the United States Army.
- 15 On September 26, 1918, Sgt. Shannon bravely gave his
- 16 life for his country after encountering hostile action in the
- 17 Argonne Forest of France.
- 18 Before serving in World War I, Sqt. Shannon fought
- in the Mexican Border War in 1917. For his actions there, he 19

- 1 was awarded the Mexican Service Medal.
- 2 (5) He is considered a hometown hero to many in the
- 3 community of Mazeppa.
- 4 (b) Designation. -- The portion of Johnson Mill Road (State
- 5 Route 1001) from the bridge over Buffalo Creek (Bridge Key
- 6 33467) to the intersection of Colonel John Kelly Road (State
- 7 Route 1002) in Buffalo Township, Union County, is designated as
- 8 the Sgt. Edward L. Shannon Memorial Highway.
- 9 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 10 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 11 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 12 Section 2. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
