- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for removal of vehicles by a
- 3 property owner and providing an implied lien for the costs of
- 4 removal.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Subsections (b) and (c) of section 3353 of Title
- 8 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
- 9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, are amended to read:
- 10 § 3353. Prohibitions in specified places.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (b) Unattended vehicle on <u>public or</u> private property.--No
- 13 person shall park or leave unattended a vehicle on <u>public or</u>
- 14 private property without the consent of the owner or other
- 15 person in control or possession of the property except in the
- 16 case of emergency or disablement of the vehicle, in which case
- 17 the operator shall arrange for the removal of the vehicle as
- 18 soon as possible.
- 19 (c) Property owner may remove vehicle.--The owner or other

- 1 person in charge or possession of any property on which a
- 2 vehicle is parked or left unattended in violation of the
- 3 provisions of subsection (b) may remove or have removed the
- 4 vehicle at the reasonable expense of the owner of the vehicle. A
- 5 person or his agent who removes a vehicle left parked or
- 6 <u>unattended in violation of the provisions of subsection (b)</u>
- 7 shall have a possessory lien against the owner of the vehicle,
- 8 in the amount of the reasonable costs or charges of removing and
- 9 storing the vehicle
- 10 * * *
- 11 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding sections to read:
- 12 § 3355. Movement of vehicles without owner's consent.
- A salvor or tower may remove a vehicle from public or private
- 14 property in accordance with section 3353(c) (relating to
- 15 prohibitions in specified places).
- 16 § 3356. Implied lien.
- 17 <u>Every driver, owner and registrant of a vehicle in this</u>
- 18 Commonwealth shall be deemed to have given consent to having the
- 19 vehicle removed at their reasonable expense and detained to
- 20 insure payment if the vehicle is removed under the provisions of
- 21 <u>section 3352 (relating to removal of vehicle by or at direction</u>
- 22 of police) or section 3353(c) (relating to prohibitions in
- 23 specified places).
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
