## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of May 2015 as "Older Americans: Get into the Act Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the energy,
- 4 aspirations and ongoing achievements of senior citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Senior citizens are the pillars upon which our
- 6 families have been built; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The increasing population of older adults in this
- 8 Commonwealth reflects a dramatic nationwide trend; and
- 9 WHEREAS, By 2030, the number of people reaching retirement
- 10 age will double; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Rural residents, on average, are older than urban
- 12 residents in this Commonwealth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The number of senior citizens in rural Pennsylvania
- 14 is projected to increase 58% through 2030; and
- 15 WHEREAS, May is traditionally recognized as "Older Americans

- 1 Month" in the United States; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Health and Human
- 3 Services Administration on Aging has announced that the theme of
- 4 Older Americans Month 2015 is "Get into the Act"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This year's theme focuses on how older adults are
- 6 taking charge of their health, getting engaged in their
- 7 communities and making a positive impact in the lives of others;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, This year marks the 50th anniversary of the Older
- 10 Americans Act, signed into law by President Lyndon Johnson in
- 11 1965; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Older Americans Act continues to provide a
- 13 nationwide aging services network and funding that helps older
- 14 adults live with dignity in the communities of their choice for
- 15 as long as possible; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Older adults are productive, active and influential
- 17 members of society, often having a positive impact on the lives
- 18 of others through the experiences and knowledge they share; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Systems and services in this Commonwealth must
- 20 adequately address the unique needs of current and future
- 21 generations of older Pennsylvanians to optimize health and
- 22 maintain independence; and
- 23 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth owes a great debt to older adults
- 24 who, united by historical experiences and strengthened by
- 25 diversity, interpret events through varied perspectives and
- 26 backgrounds to bring wisdom and insight into our communities;
- 27 and
- 28 WHEREAS, Older adults deserve recognition for the
- 29 contributions they have made and continue to make to the
- 30 culture, economy and character of the United States and this

- 1 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor
- 3 Pennsylvania's senior citizens by recognizing the month of May
- 4 2015 as "Older Americans: Get into the Act Month" in
- 5 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 7 residents of this Commonwealth to honor senior citizens and
- 8 persons who care for them during the month of May and throughout
- 9 the year and to assist in their journeys toward optimal health
- 10 and quality of life.
