AN ACT

- Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal police education and training, further defining "police department" and "police 3 officer"; and further providing for reimbursement of expenses 4 and for payment of certain county costs. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. The definitions of "police department" and "police officer" in section 2162 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 § 2162. Definitions. 11 12 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 14 context clearly indicates otherwise: * * * 15 "Police department." Any of the following: 16
- 17 A public agency of a political subdivision having
- 18 general police powers and charged with making arrests in
- connection with the enforcement of the criminal or traffic 19

- laws. This paragraph includes the sheriff's office in a county of the second class.
- 3 (2) A campus police or university police department, as
- 4 used in section 2416 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, certified
- 6 by the Office of Attorney General as a criminal justice
- 7 agency under the definition of "criminal justice agency" in
- 8 18 Pa.C.S. § 9102 (relating to definitions). This paragraph
- 9 does not include a campus police or university police
- department of the State System of Higher Education and its
- 11 member institutions.
- 12 (3) A railroad or street railway police department
- formed with officers commissioned under 22 Pa.C.S. Ch. 33
- 14 (relating to railroad and street railway police) or any prior
- statute providing for such commissioning.
- 16 (4) The Capitol Police.
- 17 (5) The Harrisburg International Airport Police.
- 18 (6) An airport authority police department.
- 19 (7) A county park police force under section 2511(b) of
- 20 <u>the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The</u>
- 21 County Code.
- 22 "Police officer." Any of the following:
- 23 (1) A full-time or part-time employee assigned to
- criminal or traffic law enforcement duties of any of the
- 25 following:
- 26 (i) A police department of a county, city, borough,
- town or township.
- 28 (ii) Any railroad or street railway police.
- 29 (iii) Any campus or university police department.
- 30 (iv) The Capitol Police.

- 1 (v) The Harrisburg International Airport Police.
- 2 (vi) An airport authority police department.
- 3 (2) A deputy sheriff of a county of the second class.
- 4 (3) A security officer of a first class city housing
- 5 authority or a police officer of a second class city housing
- 6 authority.
- 7 (4) A county park police officer.
- 8 The term excludes persons employed to check parking meters or
- 9 to perform only administrative duties and auxiliary and fire

- 12 Section 2. Section 2170 of Title 53 is amended by adding a
- 13 subsection to read:
- 14 § 2170. Reimbursement of expenses.

- 16 (a.1) County park police. -- A municipality shall be
- 17 <u>ineligible for reimbursement for tuition and expenses for the</u>
- 18 <u>certified basic training of county park police.</u>

- 20 Section 3. Section 2171 of Title 53 is amended to read:
- 21 § 2171. Payment of certain county costs.
- 22 (a) Second class counties. -- Counties of the second class
- 23 shall be liable for costs incurred for the certification of
- 24 deputy sheriffs. The costs shall not exceed the sum per police
- 25 officer assessed against municipalities.
- 26 (b) Counties generally. -- Counties shall be liable for the
- 27 costs incurred for any training required for the certification
- 28 of county park police officers.
- 29 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
