## A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of October 2009 as "Meet the Blind Month" in Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The National Federation of the Blind (NFB) was founded in 1940 to end discrimination against people who are blind and to secure first-class citizenship for all blind persons; and

WHEREAS, Today the NFB represents more than 50,000 members across this nation and continues to work to secure equal rights and opportunities for all individuals who are blind and visually impaired; and

WHEREAS, The NEB and other organizations work to change attitudes about blindness by providing information to parents, teachers, school administrators and to business, government, social and civic leaders; and
