SENATOR BELL, CONSUMER PROTECTION AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE, IN SENATE, AS AMENDED, NOVEMBER 14, 1995

## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety, by providing for the examination and licensure of those who 3 4 desire to engage in the profession of barbering; regulating 5 barber shops and barber schools, and students therein; regulating compensation for service rendered; conferring 6 7 certain powers and duties on the Department of State; and providing penalties, "further providing for the supervision 8 9 of shops. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 12(a)(1) of the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), referred to as the Barbers' License Law, 13 14 amended December 7, 1994 (P.L.855, No.123), is amended to read: 15 Section 12. (a) (1) Except for shops licensed under section 13(b) and [one barber] for one-barber shops, [barber 16 17 shops] which shall be under the immediate supervision of a licensed barber, who has been a licensed barber for one year, 18 all other barber shops shall at all times be under the immediate 19

- 1 supervision of a manager-barber. In no barber shop shall there
- 2 be more than one student <u>for each barber-teacher or manager</u>

- 3 barber in the shop. In no case shall there be more than three

- 4 TWO students per barber shop. All barber schools shall keep
- 5 prominently displayed at every entrance to said school a sign
- 6 reading "Barber School." Any copartnership, corporation, or
- 7 person desiring to operate or conduct a barber shop or barber
- 8 school, shall first secure from the board a license to do so,
- 9 and shall keep the same prominently displayed. Both the fee for
- 10 registration of each barber school and the annual renewal fee
- 11 shall be determined by regulation. The board may pass upon the
- 12 qualifications, appointments, and course of study in said
- 13 school, which shall be not less than one thousand two hundred
- 14 fifty (1250) hours and not less than nine months. All barber
- 15 schools shall have not less than one licensed teacher for every
- 16 twenty students, and in no case less than one full-time teacher,
- 17 who shall be in attendance at all times during the hours the
- 18 school is open for instruction. This section does not prohibit
- 19 an owner who is a cosmetologist from employing a barber without
- 20 the requirement that a manager-barber also be employed.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
