AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 12, 1943 (P.L.259, No.120), entitled, as
2 reenacted and amended, "An act providing for the payment by
3 the State Treasurer, of the amount of the tax on premiums
4 paid by foreign casualty insurance companies, to the
5 treasurers of the several cities, boroughs, towns, townships,
6 and certain counties, and for the payment thereof into police
7 pension funds, and in certain cases into the Municipal
8 Employees' Retirement System, and for Pension Annuity
9 Contracts, and in certain other cases into the State
10 Employees' Retirement Fund, for certain purposes," providing
11 for the allocation of moneys from refunded pension funds to
12 purchase hospital and medical insurance.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. The act of May 12, 1943 (P.L.259, No.120),
16 referred to as the Foreign Casualty Insurance Premium Tax
17 Allocation Law, reenacted and amended May 10, 1951 (P.L.250,
18 No.39), is amended by adding a section to read:

19 Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of this act, moneys
20 available from an overfunded police pension fund may be used for
21 the purchase of hospital and medical insurance for active police
22 officers covered by that pension fund.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
