AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined, " adding the State Fire 21 Safety Commission.
- 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. Section 201, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 25 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," amended
- 26 June 20, 1978 (No.70), is amended to read:
- 27 Section 201. Executive Officers, Administrative Departments

- 1 and Independent Administrative Boards and Commissions. -- The
- 2 executive and administrative work of this Commonwealth shall be
- 3 performed by the Executive Department, consisting of the
- 4 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of the Commonwealth,
- 5 Attorney General, Auditor General, State Treasurer, and
- 6 Secretary of Education; by the Executive Board, and the
- 7 Pennsylvania State Police; by the following administrative
- 8 departments: Department of State, Department of Justice,
- 9 Department of the Auditor General, Treasury Department,
- 10 Department of Education, Department of Military Affairs,
- 11 Insurance Department, Department of Banking, Department of
- 12 Agriculture, Department of Transportation, Department of Health,
- 13 Department of Labor and Industry, Department of Aging,
- 14 Department of Public Welfare, Department of General Services,
- 15 Department of Revenue, Department of Commerce, Department of
- 16 Community Affairs and Department of Environmental Resources; and
- 17 by the following independent administrative boards and
- 18 commissions: Pennsylvania Game Commission, Pennsylvania Fish
- 19 Commission, State Civil Service Commission, Pennsylvania Public
- 20 Utility Commission, the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
- 21 Commission, [and] the Pennsylvania Securities Commission and the
- 22 State Fire Safety Commission.
- 23 All of the provisions of this act, which apply generally to
- 24 administrative departments, or generally except to the
- 25 Department of the Auditor General and the Treasury Department,
- 26 shall apply to the Executive Board and to the Pennsylvania State
- 27 Police.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
