A RESOLUTION

Designating October 22, 2013, as "Kappa Alpha Psi Day" in 1 Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, Since its inception in January 1911 at Indiana University at Bloomington, Indiana, Kappa Alpha Psi has promoted 4 the spiritual, intellectual and moral welfare of its members and 5 6 the ideals of advocacy and service on behalf of members' 7 communities and the public interest; and 8 WHEREAS, Originally chartered and incorporated in Indiana as Kappa Alpha Nu on May 15, 1911, the fraternity became known as 9 10 Kappa Alpha Psi in April 1915; and 11 WHEREAS, "Achievement in every field of human endeavor" was 12 adopted as the fraternity's founding motto; and 13 WHEREAS, With hundreds of active undergraduate and alumni chapters, Kappa Alpha Psi has consistently advanced the academic 14 pursuits and aspirations of its members in keeping with the 15

1 highest principles of inclusion; and

2 WHEREAS, The City of Philadelphia is the site of the fraternity's international headquarters; and 3 4 WHEREAS, The Kappa Alpha Psi Foundation, a nonprofit, publicly supported organization, advances the fraternity's 5 philanthropic goals; and 6 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives commends Kappa Alpha 7 Psi for its impressive record of service in this Commonwealth 8 9 and beyond; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate October 10

11 22, 2013, as "Kappa Alpha Psi Day" in Pennsylvania.
