- 5 2004; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Catholic elementary and secondary schools, educating
- 7 approximately 200,000 students annually, save State and local
- 8 taxpayers more than \$1 billion each year; and

- 2 foundation of values, self-esteem, self-confidence and
- 3 leadership skills; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with
- 5 solid values and academic skills needed in becoming responsible
- 6 citizens of this Commonwealth and nation, have a dropout rate of
- 7 less than 3% and a postgraduate higher education enrollment rate
- 8 of 80%; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare the week
- 10 of January 25 through 31, 2004, as "Catholic Schools Week" in
- 11 this Commonwealth and express congratulations and appreciation
- 12 to Catholic elementary and secondary schools across this
- 13 Commonwealth on the occasion of "Catholic Schools Week" in 2004.
