## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for murder and for endangering the welfare of children; defining offenses of murder by child abuse and murder of a child; and providing penalties.

8	Section 1. Section 2502(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
9	Consolidated Statutes is amended and the definition of
10	"perpetration of a felony" in subsection (d) is amended to read:

13	(c) Murder of the third degreeAll other kinds of murder,
14	including an offense under section 2502.1 (relating to murder of

<u>a child</u>), shall be murder of the third degree. Murder of the
 third degree is a felony of the first degree.

3 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section the following
4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
5 subsection:

7 "Perpetration of a felony." The act of the defendant in 8 engaging in or being an accomplice in the commission of, or an 9 attempt to commit, or flight after committing, or attempting to 10 commit robbery, rape, or deviate sexual intercourse by force or 11 threat of force, arson, burglary [or], kidnapping[.] <u>or the</u> 12 felony offense of endangering the welfare of a child.

14 Section 2. Title 18 is amended by adding a section to read: 15 § 2502.1. Murder of a child.

A parent, guardian or other person supervising the welfare of a child under 18 years of age commits the offense of murder of a child if the person recklessly causes the death of the child. Section 3. Section 4304 of Title 18 is amended to read: 4304. Endangering welfare of children.

(a) Offense defined.--A parent, guardian, or other person supervising the welfare of a child under 18 years of age commits [a misdemeanor of the first degree] an offense if he knowingly endangers the welfare of the child by violating a duty of care, protection or support.

26 (b) Grading.--An offense under this section constitutes a 27 misdemeanor of the first degree. However, where there is a 28 pattern or there are multiple incidents of endangering the 29 welfare of a child, the offense constitutes a felony of the 30 third degree.
