AN ACT

Amending the act of February 24, 1984 (P.L.92, No.17), entitled "An act regulating the purchase and sale of precious metals," 2 further providing for definitions, for license required, for 3 records of transactions, for dealer's retention of precious 4 metal and availability for inspection and for purchases from 5 minors. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of February 24, 1984 (P.L.92, No.17), referred to as the Precious Metal Sale 10 Regulation Law, is amended by adding a definition to read: 11 12 Section 1. Definitions. 13 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 14 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 15 context clearly indicates otherwise: 16 17 "Proof of identity." An unexpired document issued by the 18 Federal Government, the Commonwealth or any other state government, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto 19

Rico or any United States territory that includes all of the

- 2 (1) The name, age and address of the seller.
- 3 <u>(2) A photograph of the seller.</u>
- 4 <u>(3) An expiration date.</u>

- 6 Section 2. Sections 2(e), 3(a), 4(a) and (b) and 5 of the
- 7 act are amended to read:
- 8 Section 2. License required.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (e) Application to be public record. -- [Such] A dealer's
- 11 <u>annual</u> license application shall be a public record <u>maintained</u>
- 12 <u>at the dealer's place of business and shall be made</u> available
- 13 to the general public for inspection upon request.
- 14 Section 3. Records of transactions.
- 15 (a) Dealers to keep record. -- Every dealer in precious metals
- 16 shall keep a record of every transaction upon a form approved by
- 17 the Attorney General. The record shall include as a minimum:
- 18 (1) [The name, age and address of the seller which must
- 19 be verified by said dealer, requiring proof of identity from
- the seller sufficient to insure the accuracy of the
- 21 represented name and address] A photocopy of the proof of
- 22 <u>identity</u> of the seller. <u>If the seller is under 18 years of</u>
- 23 age, written authority by the seller's parent, guardian or
- 24 person in loco parentis shall also be required.
- 25 (2) An accurate description of the property purchased,
- 26 including any serial number or other identifying marks or
- symbols [and], the date and hour of the transaction[.] and a
- 28 <u>photograph of each item purchased. The photograph shall be of</u>
- 29 sufficient size and clarity to identify any distinguishing
- details of a purchased item, including identifying marks,

- 3 Section 4. Dealer's retention of precious metal and
- 4 availability for inspection.
- 5 (a) Precious metal to be retained for [five] ten days.--Each
- 6 item of precious metal purchased by a dealer in precious metals
- 7 shall be retained in unaltered condition for [five] ten full
- 8 working days after report of its purchase has been filed with
- 9 the proper district attorney or his designee.
- 10 (b) Precious metal to be available for inspection. -- Such
- 11 item of precious metal shall be available for inspection, during
- 12 the [five] ten working days, by law enforcement officials of the
- 13 Federal Government, the Commonwealth or any of its
- 14 municipalities in the course of their law enforcement duties. A
- 15 search warrant shall not be required unless the inspection is
- 16 made during hours other than those when the dealer in precious
- 17 metals is open for business.
- 18 * * *
- 19 Section 5. Purchases from minors.
- The dealer in precious metals shall require any minor seeking
- 21 to sell precious metals to produce proof of identity and written
- 22 authority of a parent, guardian or person in loco parentis
- 23 authorizing the sale of such precious metals. [Such
- 24 authorization shall give the name and address of authorizing
- 25 person.] The dealer in precious metals shall verify that such
- 26 sale is authorized by [inquiry of such] contacting the parent,
- 27 guardian or person in loco parentis. Minors shall be required to
- 28 wait three full working days before receiving payment from the
- 29 sale of precious metals.
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
