AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for 2 vehicles exempt from registration; and, in licensing of drivers, further providing for persons exempt from licensing. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Sections 1302 and 1502 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding 8 paragraphs to read: 10 § 1302. Vehicles exempt from registration. The following types of vehicles are exempt from registration: 11 12 13 (2.3) Any implement of husbandry, trailer or semitrailer 14 used exclusively for agricultural operations and only 15 infrequently operated upon highways. Vehicles exempt from 16 registration under this paragraph shall be used exclusively 17 upon a farm or farms owned or operated by the owner of the 18 vehicle or upon highways between the farm or farms and a

- 12 <u>11 feet in width on a roadway for the purpose of driving that</u>
- implement between sunrise and sunset to an annual
- 14 <u>agriculture-related educational event hosted by a school</u>,
- 15 provided that the distance between the person's residence and
- the site of the event does not exceed 25 miles.
