## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled,
- as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class
- and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and
- 4 changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for
- 5 enumeration of elected officers.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 401 of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723,
- 9 No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is amended by
- 10 adding a subsection to read:
- 11 Section 401. Enumeration of Elected Officers.--\* \* \*
- 12 (d) The office of jury commissioner may be abolished if the
- 13 governing body of the county adopts, by a majority vote, a
- 14 resolution abolishing the office of jury commissioner. Upon
- 15 approval of the resolution, the office of jury commissioner
- 16 <u>shall expire at the completion of the current jury</u>
- 17 <u>commissioners' terms of office.</u>
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
