12	to provide appropriations from the Judicial Computer System
13	Augmentation Account to the Judicial Department; to provide
14	appropriations from the Motor License Fund for the fiscal
15	year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991, for the proper operation
16	of the several departments of the Commonwealth and the
17	Pennsylvania State Police authorized to spend Motor License
18	Fund moneys; and to provide for the appropriation of Federal
19	funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the
20	Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipts
21	accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1990, to June 30, 1991,
22	and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at
23	the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1990, " providing
24	additional Federal appropriations.
