14	hereby enacts as follows:	
15	Section 1. Section $\frac{9}{2}$ 10 of the act of June 18, 1974	<
16	(P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police Education	
17	and Training Law, is amended BY ADDING A SUBSECTION to read:	<
18	Section 9. Police Training Mandatory; Penalties. All	<
19	political subdivisions of the Commonwealth or groups of	
20	political subdivisions acting in concert shall be required to	
21	train all members of their police departments hired by them	
22	after the effective date of this act, pursuant to the provisions	

- 1 of this act.
- 2 Any person hired as a municipal police officer by any
- 3 political subdivision or group thereof acting in concert after
- 4 the effective date of this act shall be at the end of [one year]
- 5 two years from the date of his employment ineligible to receive
- 6 any salary, compensation or other consideration or thing of
- 7 value for the performance of his duties as a police officer
- 8 unless he has met all of the requirements as established by the
- 9 Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission and
- 10 has been duly certified as having met those requirements by the
- 11 commissioner, unless the police officer is granted additional
- 12 time to complete his training by the commissioner. However, such
- 13 persons hired as a municipal police officer will be given a
- 14 grace period of two years from the effective date of this act
- 15 before he becomes ineligible to receive salary, compensation or
- 16 other consideration of thing of value.
- 17 Any official of any political subdivision who orders,
- 18 authorizes or pays as salary to a person in violation of the
- 19 provisions of this act shall on summary conviction thereof be
- 20 sentenced to pay a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100) or be
- 21 imprisoned for a term not to exceed a period of thirty days.

- 24 Section 10. Reimbursement of Expenses. -- * * *
- 25 (d) If a police officer, within two years following
- 26 <u>certification</u>, <u>terminates</u> <u>his employment</u> <u>with the political</u>
- 27 subdivision by which he was employed at the time he was duly
- 28 <u>certified as having met the commission's requirement and</u>
- 29 thereafter obtains employment as a police officer with another
- 30 political subdivision, the political subdivision which employs

- the previously certified police officer shall reimburse the 1
- 2 political subdivision which formerly employed the police officer
- 3 for the nonreimbursable portion of the salary paid to the police
- 4 officer while complying with the provisions of this act.
- 5 Section $\frac{3}{2}$ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
