AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of April 27, 1905 (P.L.312, No.218), entitled

- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1(b) of the act of April 27, 1905
- 8 (P.L.312, No.218), entitled "An act creating a Department of
- 9 Health, and defining its powers and duties, "amended July 2,
- 10 1996 (P.L.518, No.87), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., * * *
- 12 (b) The secretary shall be the head of the department, and
- 13 shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent
- 14 of the Senate. The secretary shall be [either] a graduate of an
- 15 accredited medical or osteopathic medical school who is a
- 16 practicing physician licensed by the Commonwealth [or an
- 17 individual with professional experience in the field of public

- 1 health, health services delivery or education or training of
- 2 health service professionals]. The secretary shall serve at the
- 3 pleasure of the Governor.
