## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 22, 1964 (2nd Sp.Sess., P.L.84, No.6),
- entitled "An act to codify, amend, revise and consolidate the
  - laws relating to eminent domain, providing consequential
- 4 damages from a taking resulting from flood programs.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:

- 7 Section 1. Section 602, act of June 22, 1964 (2nd Sp.Sess.,
- 8 P.L.84, No.6), known as the "Eminent Domain Code," is amended by
- 9 adding a subsection to read:
- 10 Section 602. Measure of Damages.--\* \* \*
- 11 (f) In the case of property for which the market value has
- 12 been substantially reduced by the enactment of municipal flood
- 13 plain management regulations the measure of damages shall be the
- 14 difference between the fair market value of the entire property
- 15 <u>interest before the enactment of the municipal flood plain</u>
- 16 management regulations and as unaffected thereby and the fair
- 17 market value of the property interest remaining immediately

- 1 after the enactment of such regulations and as affected thereby
- 2 and such other damages as are provided in this code.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
