- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 14 of the act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206,
- No.43), known as the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, is 11
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 Section 14. Safe Drinking Water Account.
- 14 [All] (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection
- 15 (b), all fines and penalties collected under the penalty
- provisions of this act and all fees shall be paid into the State 16
- 17 Treasury into a special restricted receipt account in the
- 18 General Fund known as the Safe Drinking Water Account
- administered by the department for use in protecting the public 19
- from the hazards of unsafe drinking water and which funds are 20

- 1 hereby appropriated to the department for such purposes as are
- 2 authorized in this act.
- 3 (b) Fines returned to consumer. -- The department shall have
- 4 the power and may order any supplier of water assessed a civil
- 5 penalty under this act for any violations relating to the
- 6 quantity or quality of drinking water furnished to consumers to
- 7 return all or any portion of that civil penalty to affected
- 8 consumers.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
