AN ACT

1 Restricting the establishment of a facility for the storage or
2 disposal of certain nuclear and radioactive materials.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. No facility for the storage or disposal of spent
6 nuclear fuel elements or high level radioactive waste material
7 shall be constructed or established in Pennsylvania unless
8 approved by the General Assembly. Prior to making such a
9 decision, the General Assembly shall direct the Department of
10 Environmental Resources to hold hearings in the county in which
11 the proposed facility is to be located and then to report its
12 findings to the General Assembly for its approval.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
