## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act defining the liability of an 2 3 employer to pay damages for injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; establishing an elective 5 schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and 7 prescribing penalties, " providing for compensation for certain injuries suffered by off-duty law enforcement 8 officers. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. The act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known
- 13 as The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act, reenacted and
- 14 amended June 21, 1939 (P.L.520, No.281), is amended by adding a
- 15 section to read:
- Section 602. Compensation for any injury sustained by a law 16
- enforcement officer, while not on duty, which is the result of 17
- 18 activities or actions authorized or required by regulation,
- 19 including, but not limited to, the possession of service-related
- 20 firearms, shall not be barred.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
