A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for workers' rights.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 30. Workers' rights.
- 9 Employees shall have the fundamental right to organize and to
- 10 bargain collectively through representatives of their own
- 11 choosing for the purpose of negotiating wages, hours and working
- 12 conditions, and to protect their economic welfare and safety at
- 13 work. No law shall be passed that interferes with, negates or
- 14 <u>diminishes the right of employees to organize and bargain</u>
- 15 collectively over their wages, hours and other terms and

- 1 conditions of employment and work place safety, including any
- 2 law or ordinance that prohibits the execution or application of
- 3 <u>agreements between employers and labor organizations that</u>
- 4 represent employees requiring membership in an organization as a
- 5 <u>condition of employment.</u>
- 6 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 7 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 8 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- 9 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 10 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- 11 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- of Pennsylvania.
- 13 (2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of
- the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- 16 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- 17 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 18 submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this
- Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal
- 20 election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article
- 21 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
